Scholarship Loan Program for Graduate and Professional School

Initial Application Requirements:

- Proof of high school graduation or GED
- Verification of undergraduate degree and GPA
- Verification of graduate/professional degree program acceptance
- Copy of tuition bill for the first scholastic period (may be furnished upon receipt by the scholarship recipient)
- Complete the following essay questions (maximum 1,000 words each):
 - o What is your vision for what you would like Monroe and Green County to become in 10 to 20 years?
 - o How do you plan to become involved in the community to make your vision a reality?
 - o Please relate one or two situations that reveal your leadership ability.
 - o Please list and describe your current and past involvement in any community or school groups.
 - o What is your ideal career?
- Answer the following questions (Limit 200 words each):
 - o How did you pay for your undergraduate education?
 - o How would you plan to pay for your graduate education if this scholarship loan were not available?
 - o What other forms of educational payment assistance are you seeking?
- If requested, conduct an interview with the Selection & Oversight Committee.
- Provide three references that the Committee may contact. Only one reference may be a direct relative.

Continuing Loan Requirements:

- Copy of tuition bill for the upcoming scholastic period (quarter or semester)
- Documentation following the most recent scholastic period showing a minimum continuing average GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Documentation showing the loan recipient has taken the minimum number of credits in the most recent scholastic period (quarter or semester). This will vary depending on the type of program and be agreed to in the initial loan documentation.
